

How to connect to the eduroam Wi-Fi service at another location using Android 4+

These instructions will help University of Otago staff and students connect to the eduroam wireless (Wi-Fi) service at participating locations. The default eduroam WLAN settings for your Android device are:

2. Select eduroam.

Enter the following settings using the drop-down boxes in the eduroam window:

- **EAP method**: PEAP
- Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
- Identity: your University of Otago username (in the format

<username>@otago.ac.nz)
