Important Information for Scholarship Applicants

Helen Rosa Thacker Scholarship in Neurological Research

\$5,000, 1 year term, possible extension to two years upon re-application

The Helen Rosa Thacker Scholarship in Neurological Research was established by Helen Rosa Thacker in 2012 to support research and teaching in the field of neurology at the University of Otago.

The scholarship aims to recognise, reward and inspire a particularly good PhD student. This scholarship will be awarded regardless of whether the applicant has an existing scholarship. This scholarship will be awarded for one year, with a chance of extension to a second year due to outstanding progress.

Selection is based predominantly on academic merit and the applicant's potential for research. The scholarship will be paid in equal monthly instalments, ceasing on submission of thesis.

Applicants must be:

- A full time PhD student in neurological research at the University of Otago
- A male scholar holding a New Zealand birth certificate
- Available to receive the scholarship in person and provide updates on the progress of their research
