Sunday 27 November

11:00am–1:00pm (New Zealand Standard Time)

Introductory Day: Meet the tutors, do a technical check and course navigation overview. Learn how the course is run, how to find key resources and what to do before the first face to face session. Practice breakout rooms, pair programming and slide viewing. Learn the basics of slide navigation and key observations to make when answering slide questions.

Sunday 11 December

We will cover common neoplastic conditions of the globe and lacrimal gland. For each of these major topics we will work collaboratively to look at how to best answer written and slide questions. The day will include a session on mutation and cancer by Dr Michelle Thunders.

Sunday 18 December

We will cover glaucoma, diabetes, cornea and conjunctival conditions. The day will include a session on inheritance and taking a family history by Dr Michelle Thunders.
