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# Bachelor of Health Sciences

The three-year Bachelor of Health Sciences is a degree for those who want to work in the areas of:

- Community health care
- Public health
- Māori health
- Pacific and global health.

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As we face health challenges such as an aging population, increases in chronic diseases, disability, limited health resources and environmental change affecting our community's health, there is an increasing need to develop new public health care approaches.

The Bachelor of Health Sciences is a three-year degree for those who want to be an integral part of these new health care approaches, with a focus on the areas of public, Māori, Pacific and community health, where graduates may find themselves working in a variety of roles such as case managers or care co-ordinators in the health care system.

This career-focused qualification will enable you to work with patients and communities to promote health, and ensure patients are accessing and receiving the most appropriate care.

The Bachelor of Health Sciences also provides a great foundation for further study in one of the health professional programmes, or postgraduate study.
