



## University of Otago Graduates' Association Travel Scholarship

The University of Otago Graduates' Association Travel Scholarship was established in 2001 by the Graduates Association.

The scholarships shall be awarded by the University Council, as grants-in-aid to students from beyond Dunedin or its environs who have been in the preceding year enrolled at a secondary school in New Zealand and who have enrolled for a full-time course of study at the University.

### *Eligibility*

Candidates must:

- ♦ be a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand
- ♦ be from beyond Dunedin or its environs
- ♦ have been, in the preceding year, enrolled at a secondary school in New Zealand
- ♦ be eligible for a Government Allowance, for which proof must be supplied
- ♦ be enrolled for a full-time course of study at the University of Otago

### *Application and Selection Process*

Every applicant must submit:

- ♦ a completed application
- ♦ proof of eligibility for a Government Allowance

University of Otago Graduates' Association Travel Scholarships will be awarded and selected on the basis of students' results in their final year at Secondary School by a nominee of the Scholarships Committee.

Applications must be received by the Undergraduate Scholarships Administrator, Doctoral and Scholarships Office, Graduate Research Services, University of Otago, PO Box 56, Dunedin 9054 no later than **15 March** of the year in which the award is to be made.

### *Financial*

The value of the scholarships shall be from \$200 to \$600, depending on the distance of the student's home from Dunedin.

### *Tenure*

- ♦ The scholarship may be held for one year only.
- ♦ Each scholarship must be taken up in the year in which it is awarded.
- ♦ A University of Otago Graduates' Association Travel Scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other scholarship for first-year students awarded by the University of Otago, or by a student who is not eligible for a Government student allowance
