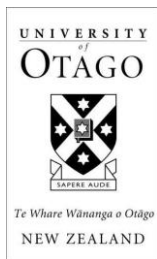




E Rewa Begg Scholarship

Established in 1989 by deed of gift from Eileen Rewa Begg whose intention was to assist able students in financial difficulty to undertake undergraduate study within the School of Business at the University of Otago.

1. The scholarship shall be awarded by the University Council.
 - (a) Annually, for such period as funds permit, on the recommendation of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Commerce)
 - (b) To a candidate undertaking a full time course of study within the School of Business who is embarking on the second year of the course for the degree of Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Commerce (Honours).
 - (c) To a candidate considered to be academically promising and who can show a need for financial assistance to complete the course.
2. The scholarship may be held for one year but, provided funds permit in any year, may be extended subject to satisfactory academic progress and to evidence of financial need.
3. The scholarship may be held concurrently with any other form of financial assistance for which a candidate is eligible.
4. The value of the scholarship is that set down in the current schedule of scholarships and prizes (current value \$2000).
