



Philip Neill Memorial Prize in Music

Established in 1943 the Prize is awarded annually for excellence in original composition.

Application is open to all past and present students of the universities of New Zealand and in 2022 is valued at \$1,500.

2022 topic and requirements:

Compose a piece for piano trio (violin, cello and piano)

- You may adopt any theme you please with the work
- Electronics or prepared piano are not permitted
- The work should be between 8-15 minutes in duration
- You should include a programme note and any performance notes necessary
- Compositions **MUST** include a computer-set musical score and a MIDI recording.
