

Health Research Excellence Awards 2019
The Dunedin School of Medicine and Southern District Health Board

Research Publication Award

This award is to recognise excellence in research by acknowledging the research calibre and effort required to produce a paper for the highest ranking journals of science and medicine.

The successful applicant will receive \$1,000 towards professional development.

To be eligible for this award the applicant must be an employee of the SDHB or DSM and the research paper must have:

- been accepted for publication between 1 January 2018 and 28 February 2019,
- the applicant as a named author.

Applications should include:

- a cover letter outlining;
 - the applicant's eligibility for the award
 - the applicant's contribution to this paper
 - the status of the journal within the discipline
 - the impact factor of the journal
- evidence of the paper's acceptance for publication
- a copy of the paper

Please note: all applications should be sent in electronic form, along with one original hard copy (A4, no staples).

Applications will be assessed on the following criteria:

- the quality of the paper
- contribution of the applicant to the paper
- impact factor of the journal in which it is published
- the status the journal has within the discipline

The applications will be assessed by a panel appointed by Health Research South.
