Best Collaboration between the DSM and Southern DHB

The purpose of this award is to acknowledge research between the DSM and Southern DHB which has been both collaborative and had a strategic focus, The award specifically aims to encourage and support the further development of a Southern DHB early career researcher and the application must demonstrate leadership shown by an early career researcher within the research team.

The successful application will receive \$5,000 towards professional development.

To be eligible for this award

- the applicant must be an employee of the DSM or Southern DHB, and
- the research team must include a Southern DHB employee with a developing interest in research (definition at the discretion of the committee) who has taken a lead role in this collaboration, and
- the collaboration should have a strategic focus.

Applications should include:

- a brief outline of the project (100 words),
- a description of the importance of the collaborative aspect of this research including what made this collaboration productive,
- a description of the strategic nature of the project,
- an explanation of the leadership role taken by the early career researcher,
- a statement of outputs such as publications, conference presentations and/or translational outcomes and student input.

Please note: all applications should be sent in electronic form, along with one original hard copy (A4, no staples).

Applications will be assessed on the following criteria:

- Quality and strategic nature of the project,
- Extent to which the collaboration influenced the quality and strategic nature of the project,
- Extent to which the early career researcher took a leadership role,
- Outcomes of the project.

The applications will be assessed by a panel appointed by Health Research South.
