## Māori Early Career Fellowships- Expressions of Interest

### Objectives

These Fellowships are intended to support and develop Māori doctoral graduates to undertake a research fellowship in any department or school within the Division of Health Sciences. The purpose of the Fellowship is to provide support for two years for researchers to gain further experience in their chosen fields, for them to become established as researchers and to support their development as future research leaders for their communities and academia.

### Eligibility

These fellowships are open to people from any discipline, from those about to graduate with a PhD to people who may have already undertaken some post-doctoral work.

### What's on offer?

- Two years of salary
- An annual travel allowance
- Help with finding a Māori mentor and career development opportunities

### Timeframe

- We would like the Fellows to start before the end of this calendar year (2022)
