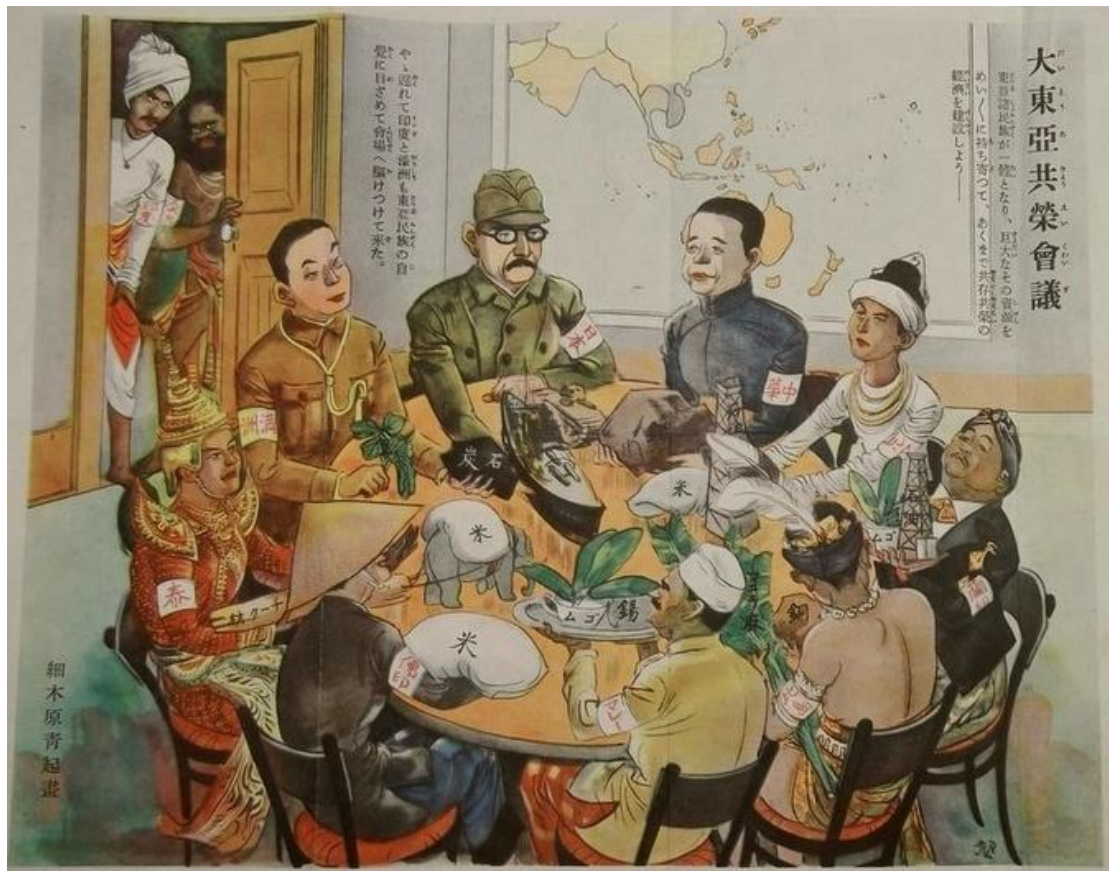

Japan's Perennial New Man:

of Masamichi Rōyama



In this talk I will analyse the political and academic career of one of Japan's leading political scientists, Masamichi Rōyama, a major intellectual apologist of the Japanese Empire in the 1930s and a major "liberal-democratic" spokesman of the postwar era. Rōyama's career is exemplary in the way it points to the curious continuities between Japanese "fascism" and "liberalism."
