Over the sea to Stewart Island

Separated from the South Island by wind-tossed Foveaux Strait, Stewart Island is New Zealand's third largest, and most southern inhabited island. Its 'twin' name is Rakiura, 'The Island of the Glowing Sky'. In 1907, botanist Dr Leonard Cockayne described Stewart Island as 'an actual piece of the primeval world'. Ninety-five years later, most of this somewhat modified 'primeval world' became New Zealand's fourteenth national park, Rakiura National Park.

STEWART Island has a long history. Evidence of the first human habitation — though it did not turn out to be permanent — is dated to c1270. Five hundred years later, in March 1770, Lieutenant James Cook sailed the *Endeavour* around its southern coasts, resolving the question as to whether or not New Zealand was part of a great 'Southern Continent'. Europeans were there some thirty years before the first colonists landed at Wellington and Auckland, and the earliest permanent occupation preceded the foundation of shore whaling stations. Even so, when trading posts and whaling settlements became parts of an organised and progressive colony, Stewart Island alone remained outside that development. An unwilling Government finally purchased it from Maori in 1864.

Although the first permanent European pioneers were seeking a home rather than a site for commercial or agriculture enterprise, Stewart Island has had eras of sealing and whaling, shipbuilding, sawmilling, tin mining, farming, fishing and tourism. Of these, only fishing and tourism have survived.

Dr Basil Howard's *Rakiura* (1940, reprinted 1974), based on his 1934 University of Otago Litt.D. thesis, remains the

classical reference book on Stewart Island's history. Since *Rakiura* was published, however, sealer John Boulton's diary has come to light, plus other historical material. Much of this new information can be found in John Hall-Jones's well-illustrated *Stewart Island Explored* (1994).

The Hocken Library has extensive holdings relating to Stewart Island and its satellite islands, and the following lists of books, theses, pamphlets and periodicals provide an introductory guide to these holdings.

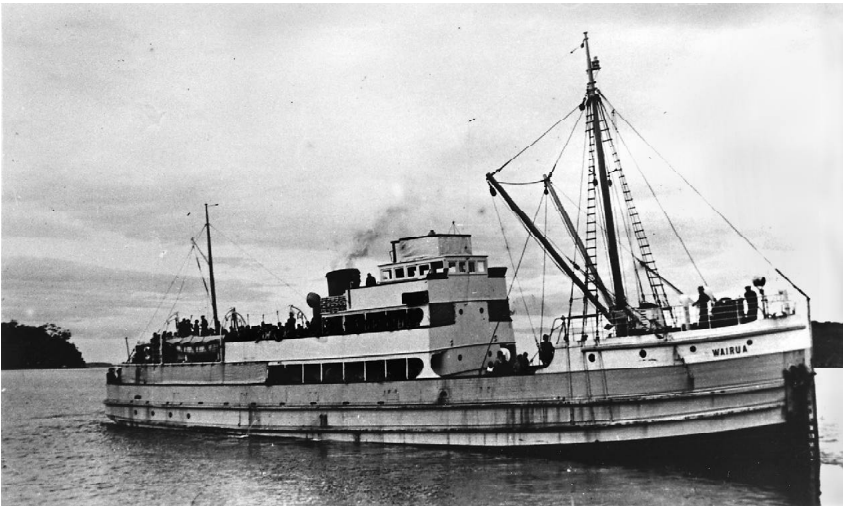

Archives and manuscripts

Check Hakena for archives and manuscripts under headings Stewart Island or Rakiura. Of special interest is a copy of extracts from Thomas Shepherd's 'Journal, March 1826 to May 1826', with a valuable early description of Stewart Island; in G.C.Thomson collection (ARC-0055, MS-0440/06).

Barlow, Maida L. Papers relating to Olga Sansom 1686–1991. Olga Sansom (1900–1989) was a third generation Stewart Islander, former director of the Southland Museum, and author of books about Stewart Island and the islanders. Her extensive archival collection, given to the Hocken Library by her daughter, Maida Barlow, includes newspaper clippings, biographical information of early settlers and families, photographs, places and place-names, ships and shipwrecks, sawmills, schools and teachers, Stewart Island County Council, shipbuilding and fishing. Natusch, Sheila, R.H. Traill Papers (Misc-MS-1661), and photocopies of his diaries, 1925–1981 (AG-816). Robert (Roy) Henry Traill (1892–1989), grandson of the Lutheran missionary, Johann Wohlers, was ranger on Stewart Island for 33 years.

Accessioned from the Archives and Manuscripts Department is the Maida L. Barlow collection of papers relating to Olga Sansom, 1686–1991 (ARC-0135).
