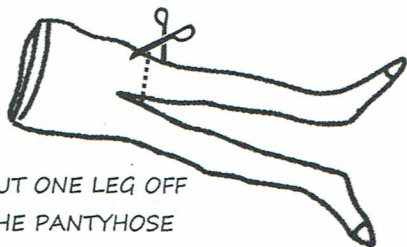

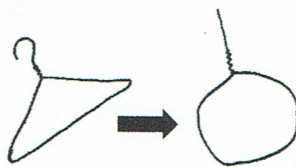
MAKE YOUR OWN PLANKTON NET



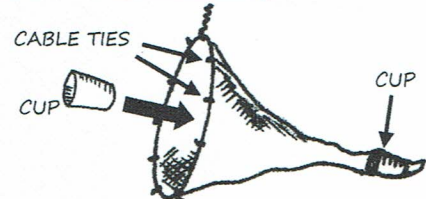
YOU WILL NEED: * SOME OLD PANTYHOSE * A WIRE COAT-HANGER * A LONG GARDEN STAKE FOR A HANDLE * A PLASTIC DRINKING CUP * A FEW CABLE TIES



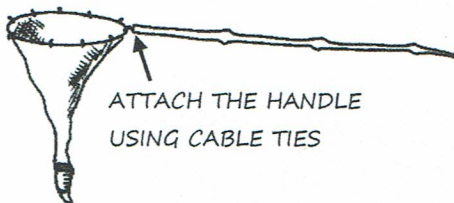
CUT ONE LEG OFF THE PANTYHOSE



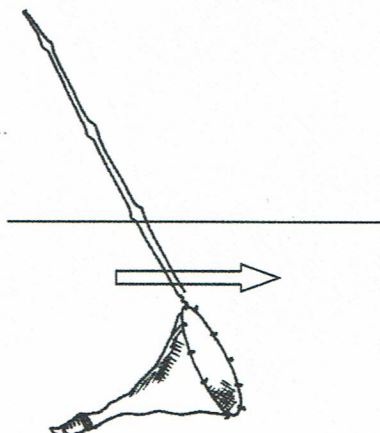
FORM A RING BY BENDING THE COATHANGER



ATTACH THE PANTYHOSE TO THE WIRE RING WITH CABLE TIES. THEN INSERT THE PLASTIC CUP INTO THE TOE END.



ATTACH THE HANDLE USING CABLE TIES



SIMPLY SWISH THE NET THROUGH THE WATER, THEN JIGGLE IT UP AND DOWN TO WASH THE PLANKTON DOWN INTO THE CUP
