CRABS ARE ONE MEMBER OF A HUGE AND DIVERSE GROUP OF ANIMALS CALLED CRUSTACEANS, WHICH INCLUDE SHRIMP, CRAYFISH, BARNACLES AND THE TINY COPEPODS FOUND IN THE PLANKTON. TRUE CRABS HAVE EIGHT WALKING LEGS AND NO OBVIOUS FEELERS, BUT HALF CRABS AND THEIR COUSINS, HAVE JUST SIX WALKING LEGS AND HAVE REALLY LONG FEELERS.

YOU MAY FIND, WHAT APPEAR TO BE, DEAD CRABS WASHED UP ON THE BEACH. CHANCES ARE THEY ARE THE OLD 'MOULTED' SHELLS LEFT BEHIND AS THE CRABS GREW. A CRAB MUST CLIMB OUT OF IT'S OLD SHELL BEFORE IT CAN GROW BIGGER - LIKE CLIMBING OUT OF A SUIT OF ARMOUR THAT IS A BIT TOO SMALL!

TRY THIS

CREEPY CRABS GAME!

Copy and cut out at least one crab per player, cutting the legs and claws from each body. The aim is to be the first to win your legs and claws back by throwing the dice. Each player must throw a 6 to start and that wins them their body, and another turn. From then on, the number thrown wins the corresponding numbered leg or claw and another turn. If you don't throw the number you need, your turn finishes.



You will need
a dice
