Auditions

Auditions will be held during early October. If candidates are visiting Dunedin prior to their scheduled audition or are unable to attend their set audition an alternate time may be arranged.

Audition Requirements

Contemporary Music (Voice and/or Instrumental)

Applicants will be required to complete:

1. A performance audition based on two contrasting pieces (covers or originals acceptable). These should last around 2 – 3 minutes each. Use of pre-recorded or live accompaniment is acceptable.
2. An interview in which applicants will be asked about their directions and goals, musical experience, musical knowledge, general education and other relevant matters. Applicants may present a resume of achievements and experience at the interview, if they wish. Applicants may be given a basic aural and sight-reading examination at the discretion of the audition panel. The audition and interview will together last about 15–20 minutes.

Musical Theatre Voice

Applicants will be required to complete:

1. A performance audition based on two contrasting musical theatre songs. These should last around 2 – 3 minutes each. These songs should give you the opportunity to act through the content of the words as well as to sing the tune.
2. A vocal range test.
3. An interview in which applicants will be asked about their directions and goals, musical experience, musical knowledge, general education and other relevant matters. Applicants may present a resume of achievements and experience at the interview. The audition and interview will together last about 15 – 20 minutes.

****Please note that due to time limitations, a vocal warm-up will not be provided as part of the audition. Applicants should come prepared.**

No matter which form of audition you do, there will be an interview either in person or via Zoom.
