<b>Exam</b>	Duration	3 hours
	Format	The exam is in two parts. Part A (33.3%) is compulsory and consists of a set of short questions, all of which should be answered. In Part B (66.7%) students choose 2 out of 3 equally weighted long answer questions.  Final exam is held in a computer lab. Students write computer code and save it to a designated directory for each question.
	Special conditions	Students are permitted to use all files available in his/her own directory and in the Common directory. Students are also permitted to use his/her laboratory book created during the semester, and copies of the lecture notes.
<b>Minimum Exam score</b>	Students must obtain at least 30% in the final examination to pass this course
