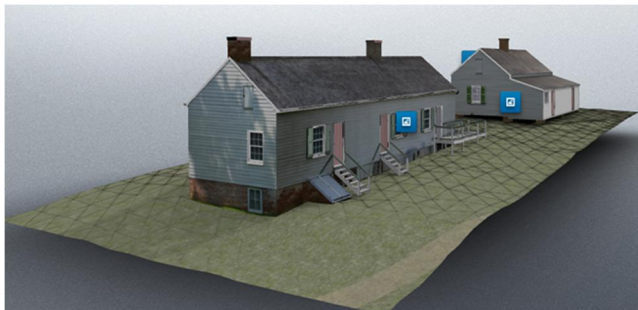


The Changing role of the Surveyor
