1. Period Covered by College Fees

- a) College opening date 17th February 2018 until 24 hours after the end of the resident's final examination or as agreed by the Head of College.

2. Student Placement and Activities Fee

- a) For full year applications, the Student Placement and Activities Fee (\$740.00) is 50% refundable for all withdrawals received prior to **1 February 2018**.
- b) The Student Placement and Activities Fee may be paid via your accommodation portal via DPS Account2Account or credit card. Internet Banking Account2Account (A2A) is available with the following banks: ANZ, ASB, BNZ, Kiwibank, TSB, Westpac.
- c) If payment is to be made by an International Bank or an alternative N.Z. bank to those listed above this needs to be direct credited directly via internet banking (please contact the College for further details).
