Richard Reid presents a masterplan for the suburb of Three Kings, Auckland, commissioned by Puketāpapa Local Board, showing how his design would improve the resilience, health and social capital of an existing suburb where intensification is taking place. Government use of high-quality spatial planning for special urban development areas will contribute to addressing New Zealand's severe housing shortage and significantly improve public health and environmental outcomes.



Richard Reid is an architect, landscape architect, urban designer and transport planner. He is a director of Richard Reid & Associates Citymakers, based in Auckland. Over the past twenty years, the practice has focused on large-scale urban projects and their integration with local communities and sensitive environments.
